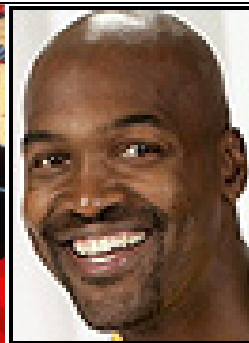

## SCOUTING REPORT ON BRYON RUSSELL:

Bryon Russell was a 2<sup>nd</sup> round draft pick (45<sup>th</sup>) by the Utah Jazz in the 1993 NBA Draft. During a 12 season NBA career that spanned most of the 1990s and into 2005, Bryon was a key member of the Utah Jazz for 9 seasons including helping Utah to back-to-back NBA finals appearances in 1997 and 1998 and is the career 3PT% leader for the Jazz. Bryon went to the Finals with the LA Lakers in 2004 as well. He also played for the Denver Nuggets, & Washington Wizards. Russell is best known for hard-nosed defense and excellent shooting. Bryon's best season was 1999-2000 when he averaged 14.1ppg and 5.2rpg & 39.6 3PT%. From 1997-2000, he played in every regular season game. Bryon Russell's veteran expertise will prove invaluable for close in-game situations and the development of younger players. "It's the passion that I have for the game," Russell says. "I play every single day. I'm definitely ready to get back in it. My age might say it's different, but at this point and time I'm still looking better than some of the [players] that are out there, in my opinion." Whatever rust Russell may have, the experience of playing in two NBA Finals with the Jazz could make him more appealing. "If a team wants me that would be great because I know I can definitely help them" he said.

**Career Milestones:** Career-high 15 rebounds in 37 minutes against the Cleveland Cavaliers on 3/16/2000. Ranked third in NBA in steals per turnover at 1.27, 19th in steals (1.56), and 26th in three-point field goal percentage (.396) in 1999-2000...Led the Jazz in 1998-99 in three-pointers made (52) and attempted (147) and ranked 2nd on the team in scoring (12.4 ppg), three-point percentage (.354) and steals (1.52 spg)...Led the Jazz and established career-highs in 1997-98 in three-pointers made (73) and attempted (214). Scored a season-high 21 points twice in 1997-98...Appeared in the 1997 and 1998 NBA Finals against the Chicago Bulls...Posted a playoff career-high 29 points and 10 rebounds against the L.A. Lakers in Game 4 of the 1997 West. Conf. Semifinals...Has appeared in 105 career NBA Playoff games with 9.9 ppg and 4.2 rpg.
