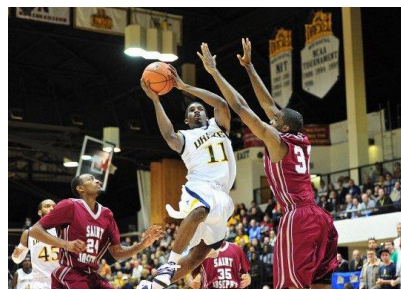

### High School:

New York, NY / St. Raymond's High School - HS All-City Daily News All-Star 2007

- Led St. Raymond's to the city championship game
- Scored more than 1,000 points in his career and was in the top five in the Catholic High School Athletic Association in scoring in both his junior and senior seasons
- Averaged 15 points, 4 assists and 2 steals as a senior and shot 43% from the floor
- Named Student-Athlete of the Week by the Daily News in 2006
- Was a member of both the Student Council and the Honor Society

2007-2008 Drexel (NCAA) 32 games: 6.5ppg, 1.8rpg, 1.2apg, 32.4FG%, 3Pts: 31.4%, 53.1FT%

- Played in every game in his first season in University City
- Averaged 6.5 points per game as a rookie, fifth best on the team
- #2 on the club with 43 three-pointers
- Sank at least one three-pointer in 22 games
- Opened his career with 18 points at Penn, the most by a Drexel freshman in his debut since Michael Anderson scored 19 in 1984
- 6-for-9 from behind the arc in that game & named the CAA Rookie of the Week
- Scored 14 points and made four three-pointers in just 20 minutes against Rider
- Also reached double figures vs. Northeastern (12), Florida Gulf Coast (12), Temple (11), Navy (10) and George Mason (10)
- Scored nine points in the loss to Delaware in the CAA Tournament.

- Finished 2<sup>nd</sup> on the team with 9.0 points per game
- Scored at least 10 points in 11 games...nailed 29 three-pointers
- Poured in 18 points in win vs. Loyola and nailed four three-pointers
- Came off the bench to score a team-high 14 points in win at Towson
- Career-high 21 points at Bucknell and added three assists
- Scored all 13 of his points in the second half in a win at Rider
- Led the team with 12 points and four assists against Mason
- Scored 13 points and had five boards and two steals in the win vs. Cal State Northridge
- Contributed 11 points vs. No. 22 Georgetown and at Georgia State
- Had 47 assists and 19 steals...made at least one trey in 13 of his last 16 games.

- Appeared in all 32 games and started every game except senior day as a junior
- Finished 3<sup>rd</sup> on the club with 9.2 points per game
- Scored a season-high 19 points and sank four three-pointers vs. VCU
- Poured in 18 points at Niagara during ESPN's College Hoops Tip-Off Marathon
- Recorded 17 points and had a season-high four steals at Cal-State Northridge
- Reached double figures in points on 15 games
- 2<sup>nd</sup> on the team with 101 assists and tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> with 32 steals
- Handed out a career-high eight assists against UNC Wilmington
- Entered his senior year with 96 three-pointers and just 251 points shy of 1,000.
