July 28, 2007 - Richard Washington was selected as the 3<sup>rd</sup> TOP PROSPECT OVERALL while being named to the ELITE 22 from the over 200 registered athletes at the ARENA FOOTBALL LEAGUE 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Combine. He was selected #1 TOP WIDE RECEIVER PROSPECT after running the #1 top time in the 40 yard dash with a 4.36 and the 4<sup>th</sup> best time on the Short Shuttle with a 3.93. Richard was described as follows: This Fort Myers, (Fl.) native is simply a few positive breaks away from being in the NFL. He has the ability to change a game. Any game! 2003 - Richard was regarded as the "Next Deion Sanders" coming out of high school. He was moved to flanker at NC State. He appeared in 9 games in 2003. 3<sup>rd</sup> on the team with 44 receptions for 500 yards (11.4 avg) and six touchdowns. He added 28 yards on eight carries (3.5 avg) and recovered a blocked punt for a score. His six scoring grabs set a school season-record for a freshmen and his catches and receiving yards rank second on the Wolfpack's annual record chart for first-year players.

2004 - Washington started 5 of 8 games at flanker. Missed three games due to knee injury. Finished 2<sup>nd</sup> on team with 29 catches, 348 yards (12.0 avg) and 2 TD's. Added 133 yards on 12 carries (11.1 avg), 6 yards on a punt return, 155 yards on seven kickoff returns (22.1 avg) and 2 solo tackles.

In only 17 games at North Carolina State, Richard caught 73 passes for 848 yards (11.6 avg) and 8 TD's. He gained 161 yards on 20 carries (8.1 avg) and recorded two solo tackles. He added 155 yards on seven kickoff returns (22.1 avg) and 6 yards with a touchdown on two punt returns.

### SCOUTING REPORT ON RICHARD WASHINGTON:

Once he is on the move, he does a good job of gobbling up the cushion... Good route runner who is best when avoiding defenders and finding the holes rather than attacking the opponent... Shows a smooth weave, good leverage and quick transition to accelerate through his speed cuts... Settles instinctively underneath and carries route depth well... Gains separation with his ability to sink his hips and accelerate through the cut... Has the speed to get down field and the jumping ability to compete for the ball in flight... Has a knack for locating the ball on a late read or with his back to the quarterback... While he doesn't always generate his second gear, he is a dangerous threat with the ball in his hands because of his elusiveness and hip wiggle that generally makes the initial tackler miss. He is a phenomenal competitor who plays with high energy and he has a great attitude. Richard takes direction well and works hard day in and day out. He is very coachable.
