PROFILE SUMMARY

Coach Pickering has been involved in basketball for **over 29 years**. He has **served as a Head Coach, General Manager, Scout, Player Personnel Director and Owner**. He played collegiately at **Spring Arbor University, Michigan**, and then moved on to college coaching stints at **Marion College, Indiana; Texas Wesleyan University (where he also earned a Masters Degree in Sports Psychology); and John Brown University, Arkansas**. Then, he started his professional coaching/directing career. In **1997, Pickering founded the Montecito Basketball Academy, mentoring over 9,000 youths in the Santa Barbara community**. The Academy **teaches the fundamentals of the game during the week and provides tournaments and in-house games on the weekends**. He also has **coached in Austria, Kuwait, the United Arab Emirates, Canada and Venezuela and he conducted clinics in Costa Rica, Guatemala, the Phillipines, Bahrain and Hungary**. He notched his **300th career coaching victory on May 31, 2008 when the Breakers beat the Ventura Jets 113-108** at Santa Barbara City Sports Pavilion.
